<b>1Jo 4:9</b>	In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.
<b>1Jo 4:10</b>	Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son [to be] the propitiation for our sins.
<b>2Sa 7:19</b>	And this was yet a small thing in thy sight, O Lord GOD; but thou hast spoken also of thy servant's house for a great while to come. And [is] this the manner of man, O Lord GOD?
<b>Psa 31:19</b>	[Oh] how great [is] thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; [which] thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!
<b>Psa 36:7</b>	How excellent [is] thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.
<b>Psa 36:8</b>	They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures.
<b>Psa 36:9</b>	For with thee [is] the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

<b>Psa 89:1</b>	[[Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite.]] I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.
<b>Psa 89:2</b>	For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever: thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.
<b>Jhn 3:16</b>	For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
<b>Rom 5:8</b>	But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
<b>Rom 8:32</b>	He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
<b>Eph 2:4</b>	But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
<b>Eph 2:5</b>	Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
<b>Eph 3:18</b>	May be able to comprehend with all saints what [is] the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
<b>Eph 3:19</b>	And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.
<b>that</b>	
<b>Jer 3:19</b>	But I said, How shall I put thee among the children, and give thee a pleasant land, a goodly heritage of the hosts of nations? and I said, Thou shalt call me, My father; and shalt not turn away from me.
<b>Hsa 1:10</b>	Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, [that] in the place where it was said unto them, Ye [are] not my people, [there] it shall be said unto them, [Ye are] the sons of the living God.
<b>Jhn 1:12</b>	But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, [even] to them that believe on his name:
<b>Rom 8:14</b>	For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
<b>Rom 8:15</b>	For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
<b>Rom 8:16</b>	The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

<b>Rom 8:17</b>	And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together.
<b>Rom 8:21</b>	Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
<b>Rom 9:25</b>	As he saith also in Osee, I will call them my people, which were not my people; and her beloved, which was not beloved.
<b>Rom 9:26</b>	And it shall come to pass, [that] in the place where it was said unto them, Ye [are] not my people; there shall they be called the children of the living God.
<b>2Cr 6:18</b>	And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.
<b>Gal 3:26</b>	For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
<b>Gal 3:29</b>	And if ye [be] Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.
<b>Gal 4:5</b>	To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.
<b>Gal 4:6</b>	And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
<b>Rev 21:7</b>	He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
<b>the world</b>	
<b>Jhn 15:18</b>	If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before [it hated] you.
<b>Jhn 15:19</b>	If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.
<b>Jhn 16:3</b>	And these things will they do unto you, because they have not known the Father, nor me.
<b>Jhn 17:25</b>	O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
<b>Col 3:3</b>	For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
